I Proudly Join Lights Out CT

As a CT resident, business, school, church, and/or property owner, I pledge to help protect migratory birds by minimizing all unnecessary lights each night from **11pm to 6am** during peak bird migration (Spring: Apr 1–May 31 & Fall: Aug 15–Nov 15) and make seasonal lighting changes. Specific actions include:

- Turn off floodlights, spotlights, & decorative lighting.
- Install lighting controls (timers & motion detectors), for energy savings & improved security.
- Down-shield all exterior lights.
- Turn off unneeded indoor lights.
- Substitute task lighting and draw blinds & shades after 11pm.
- In larger buildings, reduce lobby, hallway, & atrium lighting, wherever possible.
